

HOPE, LOVE and PROMISES

Scriptures of Hope

This is not about words, so please don't let words get in your way as you read. We use the Father's true name, Yahweh, and the Savior's name, Yahshua. "Elohim" is a Hebrew word meaning "mighty being". "Shalom" means peace and good things of every kind. The meaning of these scriptures should be clear in any Bible you have. The scriptures used in this study will all be from the King James Version. Deeper study is always encouraged.

Take time to meditate on these thoughts. These things are spiritual, powerful and eternal for us. They are especially important in times of trouble, loss and tribulation. Read them and take them personally as if Yahshua is talking to you, for He is. Yahshua is Yahweh of the Old Testament. If you want, you can send for studies on the Sacred Names.

OUR COVENANT

Mark 12:29-31 And Yahshua answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; Yahweh our Elohim, Yahweh is one Elohim: 30 And thou shalt love Yahweh thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength; This is the first commandment. 31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

SET A PART

Psalm 51:7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

2 Corinthians 1:3-11 Blessed be Elohim, even the Father of our Master Yahshua Messiah, the Father of mercies, and the Elohim of all comfort; 4 Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of Elohim. 5 For as the sufferings of Messiah about in us, so our consolation also aboundeth by Messiah. 6 And whether we be afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in the enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer; or whether we be comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. 7 And our hope of you is steadfast, knowing, that as ye are partakers of the sufferings, so shall ye be also of the consolation. 8 For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life: 9 But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in Elohim which raiseth the dead: 10 Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us; 11 Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

PEACE AND HOPE

2 Corinthians 4:16-18 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. 17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; 18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Isaiah 51:13 And forgettest Yahweh thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? And where is the fury of the oppressor?

Isaiah 54:10 “For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed,” saith Yahweh that hath mercy on thee.

John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in Elohim, believe also in me. 2 In my Father’s house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again,

and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Luke 12:32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Isaiah 33:2 O Yahweh, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble.

Psalms 62:5-8 My soul, wait thou only upon Elohim; for my expectation is from him.

Isaiah 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Psalms 32:1 Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

Psalms 145:13-21 KJV 13 Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. 14 Yahweh upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down. 15 The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. 16 Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. 17 Yahweh is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works. 18 Yahweh is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. 19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them. 20 Yahweh preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy. 21 My mouth shall speak the praise of Yahweh: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

Psalms 73:23-26 Nevertheless I am continually with thee: thou hast holden me by my right hand. 24 Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me to glory. 25 Whom have I in heaven but thee? And there is none upon earth that I desire beside thee. 26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but Elohim is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever. **Psalms 73:28** But it is good for me to draw near to Elohim: I have put my trust in the Sovereign Yahweh, that I may declare all they works.

TESTING

1 Peter 1:6-7 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: 7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Yahshua Messiah.

Job 23:10 But he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

James 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall in fivers temptations; 3 Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. 4 But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which Yahweh hath promised to them that love him.

James 5:10-11 Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of Yahweh, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. 11 Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of Yahweh; that Yahweh is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

Acts 14:22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of Elohim.

Romans 5:3-5 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope: 5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of Elohim is shed abroad in our hearts by the Ruach ha Kodesh which is given unto us.

Roman 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love Elohim, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Isaiah 57:1-2 The righteous perisheth, and no man layeth it to heart: and merciful men are taken away, none considering that the righteous is taken away from the evil to come. 2 He shall enter into peace: they shall rest in their beds, each one walking in his uprightness.

HIS LOVE

Romans 8:35-39 Who shall separate us from the love of Messiah? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that love us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of Elohim, which is in Messiah Yahshua our Sovereign.

Zephaniah 3:17 Yahweh thy Elohim in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Hebrews 12:1-3 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, **2** Looking unto Yahshua the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the stake, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of Elohim. **3** For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Proverbs 28:13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.

Matthew 28:20 Teaching them of observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen. the early and latter rain.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

James 5:7-8 Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Master. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receiveth the early and latter rain.

Psalms 31:7 I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;

Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in Yahweh.

Psalms 27:14 Wait on Yahweh: be of good courage, and he shall strength thine heart: wait, I say, on Yahweh.

Psalms 27:7-8 Hear, O Yahweh, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me. **8** When though saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy

face, Yahweh, will I seek.

Isaiah 40:28-31 Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard, that the everlasting Elohim, Yahweh, the creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching of his understanding. 29 He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. 30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: 31 But they that wait upon Yahweh shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Isaiah 41:17 When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I Yahweh will hear them, I the Elohim of Israel will not forsake them.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Philippians 4:11-13 Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. 12 I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. 13 I can do all things through Messiah which strengtheneth me.

Philippians 4:19 But my Elohim shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Yahshua Messiah.

Philippians 3:13-14 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, 14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of Elohim in Messiah Yahshua.

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also healeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Isaiah 25:9 And it shall be said in the day, Lo, this is our Elohim; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is Yahweh; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

Psalms 25:14-18 The secret of Yahweh is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant. 15 Mine eyes are ever toward Yahweh; for he shall pluck my feet out

of the net. 16 Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted. 17 The troubles of my heart are enlarged: O bring thou me out of my distresses. 18 Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.

ETERNITY WITH THE SAINTS

Revelations 21:1-7 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. 2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from Elohim out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of Elohim is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and Elohim himself shall be with them, and be their Elohim. 4 And Elohim shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. 5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. 6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Aleph and Tau, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. 7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his Elohim, and he shall be my son.

Revelations 7:17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and Elohim shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

THE RESURRECTION OF THE SAINTS AT HIS COMING

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as other which have no hope. 14 For if we believe that Yahshua died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Yahshua will Elohim bring with him. 15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Master, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Master shall not prevent them which are asleep. 16 For the Sovereign himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Yahweh: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first: 17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Master in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Master. 18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Messiah risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.

1 Corinthians 15:22-23 For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive. **23** But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah's at his coming.

1 Corinthians 15:42-44 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: **43** It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power: **44** It is sown in natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith Yahweh, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

Aaronic Blessing on the Faithful

Numbers 6:24-27 Yahweh bless thee, and keep thee: **25** Yahweh make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: **26** Yahweh lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. **27** and they shall put my name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.
